## Course Harbour View Lunch

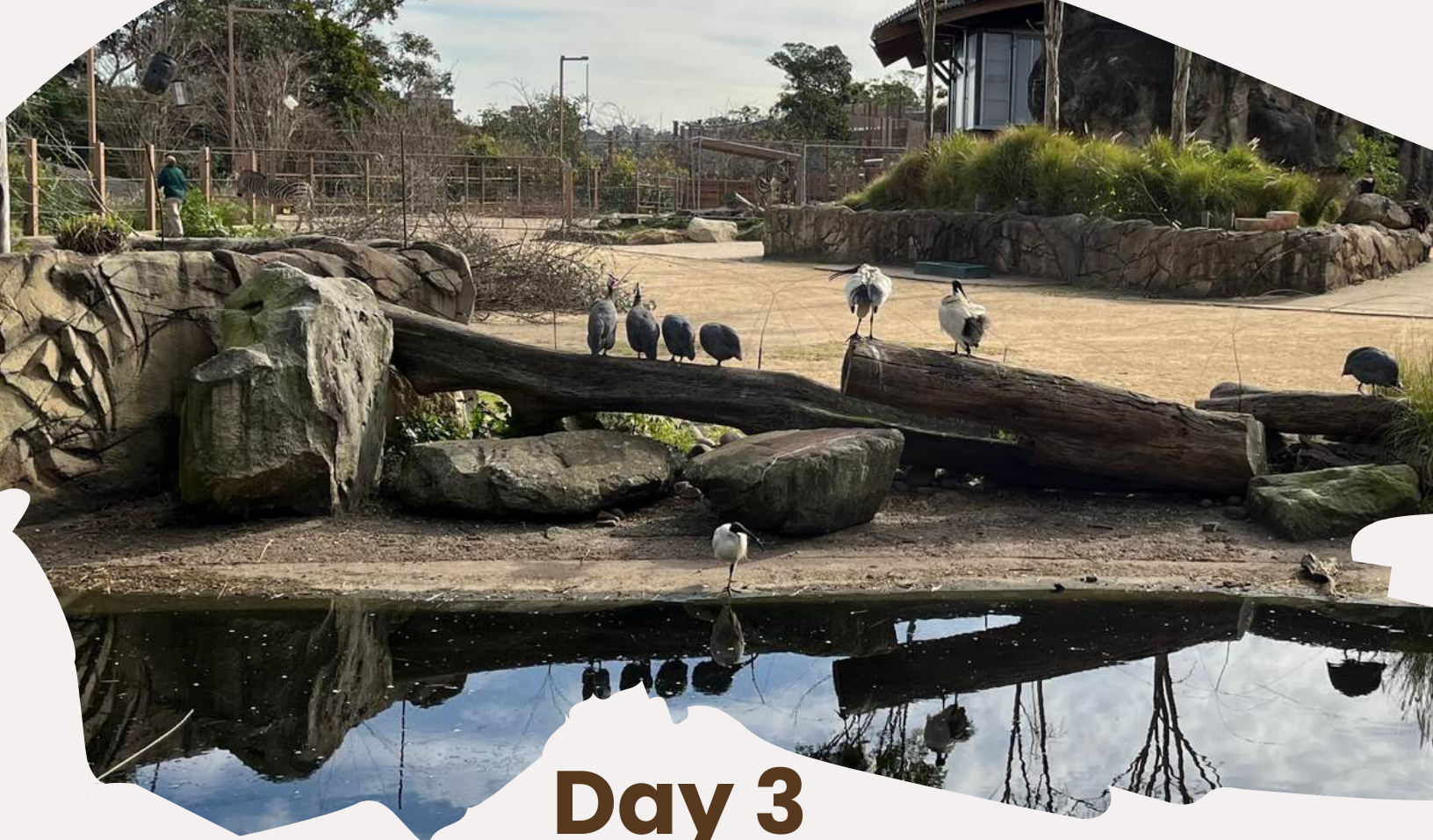


The Harbour Lunch Cruise is a great way to experience spectacular Sydney Harbour over lunch. Featuring two-course à la carte, this is one waterfront restaurant with endless and ever-changing Sydney Harbour views. Sightseeing, weekday work lunches, or weekend lunch escapes are a breeze with this zippy 90-minute on-water venue.

See inside the world's most recognizable sails. Experience this miracle of architecture and engineering. A work of art that came into existence against impossible odds, to become one of the busiest performing arts centers in the world. Working with new, rich audio-visual components, where images are projected onto the fabric of the building, your guide will take you on an emotional journey, immersing you in a story that rivals any opera plot with its dramatic twists and turns.

Experience being guided into theatres, given a fascinating account of the history and architecture of the House and introduced to the magic of performance. With its white, sculptural 'shells' rising from the harbour foreshore at Bennelong Point, the Opera House is Sydney's most recognizable building and, officially, one of the seven wonders of the 20th century.

## **Day 3 Sydney Zoo**

**Sydney Zoo – the gateway to the majestic Blue Mountains. The showpiece is the Bungarribee Wildlife Experience, where visitors get close to Australia’s unique and friendly koalas, kangaroos and a huge range of other native species. Immerse yourselves in an Aussie bush safari and get up close to Sydney’s largest collection of Australian native animals. Get up close to a koala, pat a kangaroo and meet other iconic Australian animals. Visit the largest Reptile and Nocturnal House in the Southern Hemisphere and underwater viewing of penguins, saltwater crocodile, bull sharks and native fish. Discover Aboriginal culture and art through the guidance of local Aboriginal experts.**

### **Blue Mountains – Spectacular Wilderness Parks**

**The Blue Mountains, named for their distinctive blue haze (a result of eucalyptus oil evaporating from millions of gum trees), have long been a popular getaway destination for Sydneysiders.**

**The mountains are a natural wonderland of untamed bush, spectacular rock formations, and native wildlife. This is one of the most spectacular and captivating wilderness parks in the country, and a supreme example of Australia's diversity.**

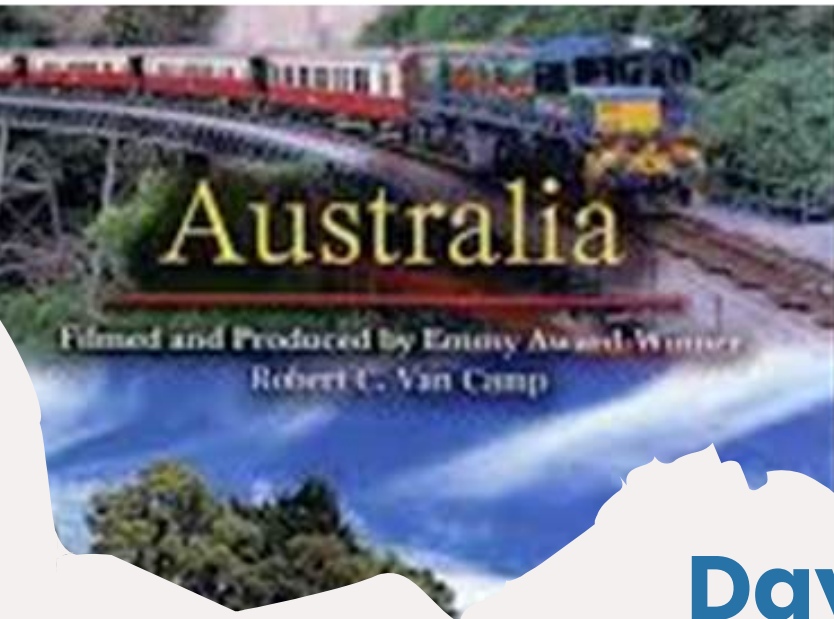
### Experience Historic Townships

Travel through the historic townships of Blaxland, Springwood, Lawson, and Wentworth Falls.

### Scenic Railway, Walkway, Cableway, and Skyway

**Scenic Railway** – Discover the thrill of a 52-degree incline riding the steepest passenger railway in the world, the Scenic Railway.

**Scenic Walkway** – Discover the tranquility of the ancient rainforest while strolling along the 2.4 km Scenic Walkway. The elevated boardwalk immerses you in a Jurassic rainforest on the Jamison Valley floor with minimal impact on the environment.

**Scenic Cableway** – Discover panoramic views of the World Heritage-listed Blue Mountains from the Scenic Cableway.

**Scenic Skyway** – Glide between cliff tops and gaze at the rainforest canopy through the glass floor of the Scenic Skyway!
